- Discharges from the disinfection of potable water supply pipelines, tanks, reservoirs, etc.
- Discharges from potable water supply systems resulting from system failures, pressure releases, etc.
- Aquifer testing wastes
- Diverted stream flow

The City of Rancho Cucamonga requires that a "non-storm water discharge notification form" be submitted to the engineering services Department for approval of these discharges, five days prior to any planned discharges, or as soon as possible for unplanned discharges. Monitoring may also be required for these discharges.
