North Etiwanda Preserve Closure Due to Fire Danger

July 2, 2014

Rancho Cucamonga, California – The Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District and the San Bernardino County Fire Department will be implementing a joint closure of the North Etiwanda Preserve due to increased fire danger. The closure is being implemented pursuant to Rancho Cucamonga Fire Protection District Ordinance FD-054 and San Bernardino County Fire Code Section 11 to provide for public safety and prevent the ignition of a wildfire due to dangerous fire conditions and extremely low vegetation fuel moistures. The closure is effective from sunset July 3, 2014 through 6:00 a.m. July 5, 2014. A violation of this closure is punishable by a fine of \$1,000.
