Rancho Cucamonga Wilson Avenue Extension Project – East Avenue to Wardman Bullock Road

Rancho Cucamonga, California – City of Rancho Cucamonga officials recently provided an update to the much anticipated Wilson Avenue Extension Project. Work has begun on the Wilson Avenue extension project from East Avenue to Wardman Bullock Road. The contractor started staging equipment and placing protective barriers to the designated area in the beginning of November.

The Wilson Avenue extension project will improve the Fire District's response time to residents north of Wilson, as well as help to alleviate congestion of school traffic in and around Colony Elementary and Summit Intermediate schools.

Work on this project is anticipated to continue through late spring of 2015. The public should expect to see continued grading and installation of water and storm drains during December 2014 and January 2015, construction of wildlife crossings in February and March 2015, and the final improvements of surface improvements in April and May 2015.

The project will consist of a two-lane road (one in each direction) with an asphalt walkway and streetlights on the south side, bike lanes on the north and south sides, and a directional turnabout installed at the north end of East Avenue. The City will host a community event in the spring for everyone to come out and celebrate the completion of the Wilson Avenue Extension.
