Volunteers affiliated with the ReadyRC program support services provided by the Rancho Cucamonga Fire District, including community outreach efforts, administrative functions, and disaster response for significant incidents.

Volunteer Opportunity: Large Animal Response Team (LART)

The Fire District is seeking enthusiastic, self-motivated individuals to offer large animal evacuation support in a large scale emergency. Must be able to take direction from and work cooperatively with the Animal Services and Sheriff's Departments.

Duties: Respond during emergencies and catastrophic disasters to assist with large animal evacuation.

Qualifications: Experience with large animals, National Incident Management System (NIMS) training.

Commitment Expected: Register with the Fire District by completing a Volunteer Application through Volgistics, the District's online volunteer management database; attend a meeting/orientation; and take the Disaster Service Worker Loyalty Oath. Additionally, LART members will attend regular meetings lead by Emergency Management Program staff and will be subject to all Standard Operating Procedures as designated by the Emergency Management Program. LART applicants must successfully pass a Department of Justice (DOJ) background check via Livescan.

Training: LART volunteers will be provided opportunities for additional training to maintain and gain knowledge regarding large animal evacuation.

Minimum Age: 16

Availability needed: Ongoing
