The Program recognizes businesses who have demonstrated a commitment toward environmental sustainability. Mindrum Precision, located at 10000 Fourth Street, is a full-service machine shop providing custom manufacturing of ultra-precision components and assemblies in glass, ceramic and metal materials. They have incorporated a variety of green practices into their business operations that promote energy efficiency, water conservation, and waste reduction.

The Healthy RC Green Business Recognition Program showcases the sustainability efforts of Rancho Cucamonga businesses and encourages green practices throughout the business community. Businesses that demonstrate environmental practices in various categories such as waste reduction, pollution prevention, recycling, green purchasing, energy efficiency, water efficiency, transportation, and stakeholder engagement and complete no-cost energy, water, and/or waste reduction audits are eligible to be recognized as a Healthy RC Green Business. Participating businesses receive recognition and exposure through various City outlets and at a City Council meeting, and are provided with a Healthy RC "Green Business" window decal to display at their business entrance. Participating businesses are also featured in the City's *Rancho Reporter* community newsletter, on the City's Healthy RC website and on the *Healthy RC Living Show* broadcast on the City's Government Access channel, RCTV-3. The Green Business Recognition Program is part of the overall City's Healthy RC Initiative and promotes environmentally sustainable practices in the community.

"The City is delighted to have Mindrum Precision participate in the Green Business Recognition Program. We are looking forward to celebrating Mindrum Precision's commitment to environmental sustainability." said Deborah Allen, Management Aide.

Mindrum Precision's commitment to sustainability is impressive. To maximize energy efficiency, machine shop lighting was replaced with more efficient T8 fluorescent tubes and a solar photovoltaic system offsets the remaining electricity use. Water conservation efforts include the recycling and filtering of water used in the high-precision machining lab and installing drought-tolerant plants outside the building. Waste reduction efforts include implementing paper waste reduction strategies and reducing, reusing, and recycling shop materials and supplies. CEO Diane Mindrum has been instrumental in formulating the company's vision for sustainability and has worked collaboratively with her staff to reduce their environmental footprint.
