



HAUNTED HOUSES AND OTHER AMUSEMENT TYPE EVENTS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS ENGINEERING REQUIREMENTS

Engineering Services Department - Temporary Street and Lane Closures Permit

- *Temporary Street and Lane Closures Permits are required by the Rancho Cucamonga Municipal Code for the closure of lanes or entire street segments. The following items must be submitted by the applicant and approved by the City Engineer prior to issuance of a Street Closure Permit.*
- *Permit Application for Temporary Street and Lane Closures including applicable application and plan check fees*
- *Agreement with the Police Department regarding coordination and implementation of Police services for the event*
- *Certificate of Insurance, in a form acceptable to the City's Risk Management Coordinator, naming the City as an additional insured and providing a minimum coverage of \$2,000,000*
- *Temporary Traffic Control Plan (TCP) prepared by a California registered Civil or Traffic Engineer in accordance with the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*
- *Rental Agreement with a private traffic control contractor to place and maintain the traffic control devices shown on the approved TCP for the duration of the event*
- *Letter signed by all affected property owners agreeing to the proposed temporary closure*
