Rancho Cucamonga is Recognized as a 2018 Digital Cities Survey Award Recipient

Rancho Cucamonga, California - The City of Rancho Cucamonga was recognized as a 2018 Digital Cities Survey award recipient on November 2, 2018 by the Center for Digital Government. Scoring in the 125,000 to 249,000 population range, the City of Rancho Cucamonga was listed as one of 10 cities in the United States who use data to enhance a broad range of City services.

According to the Center for Digital Government, the survey used to award recipients recognizes cities who use technology to tackle social challenges, enhance cybersecurity, improve transparency and much more. The survey honors cities in five population classifications: 500,000 or more; 250,000 to 499,999; 125,000 to 249,999; 75,000 to 124,999 and fewer than 75,000.

“Rancho Cucamonga’s elected leadership have made it a practice to establish, examine, and evaluate a set of comprehensive goals to provide a vision and direction for staff to build and execute programs for the community,” said Darryl Polk, Director of Innovation and Technology for the City of Rancho Cucamonga. “These goals are an expression of the City Council’s agreed upon roadmap for the City, executing community services, enhancing internal mechanisms and improving the overall value of government to the people who live, work and play in Rancho Cucamonga.”
