



# Yard Sale Ordinance

(Effective: 8/20/07)

## Goal:

This regulation was enacted in order to minimize increased traffic and noise that may be caused by yard sales, especially during early morning hours or on a recurring base. The intent is to allow residents reasonable opportunities to conduct legitimate yard sales while minimizing adverse impacts on adjoining residents.

## Definition:

The Municipal Code defines a “yard sale” as a temporary sale of household items within a residential zone.

## Restrictions:

Residents who are considering having a yard sale are reminded that:

- ✓ Items displayed, offered, or sold at the sale may only be routine household items used or stored at the location of the sale;
- ✓ Yard sales may be conducted on one day, but not to exceed two consecutive days, within a six month period;
- ✓ Yard sales may only be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.;
- ✓ No signs are permitted on public property (parkway areas and trees, sidewalks, utility poles, etc.). Please find an alternative way to advertise your yard sale.
