


# TEMPORARY SIGN INFORMATION

**Temporary Sign Permit Required.** All temporary signs require a Temporary Sign Permit prior to their establishment. Temporary signs may include, but are not limited to, commercial signs for grand openings or for special product, sale, or event advertising. All temporary signs have a maximum display period of ninety (90) days per calendar year, either consecutive or intermittent and must comply with the standards listed in section 17.74.090 of the Rancho Cucamonga Development Code.

## **Types of Temporary Signs:**


### **1. Wall Mounted Banners:**

- Must be located on the exterior of the unit occupied by the business.
- Must be affixed to the building face below the roof line.
- Maximum sign area of fifty (50) sq ft.
- Cannot be tied between trees, or hung on a fence or railing.




### **2. Ground Mounted Signs:**

- All freestanding signs not attached to a building are considered to be ground mounted.
- Such signs must be solidly constructed with upright posts affixed to the ground.
- Maximum height of eight (8) ft.
- Maximum sign area of fifty (50) sq ft.
- Must be located on the property where the business or activity is located.
- When multiple businesses exist on the site, the sign must be immediately adjacent to the unit occupied by the business.
- A building permit is required for signs over six (6) feet in height.



### **3. Flags:**

- One (1) flag is permitted per business.
- Maximum height of fifteen (15) ft.
- Maximum sign area of thirty (30) sq ft.
- Must be set back five (5) ft from Right-of-Way (ROW).
