Volunteer Opportunity: Advanced CERT

The Fire District is seeking enthusiastic, self-motivated individuals to offer emergency response support to our community in a large scale emergency.

Duties: Respond during emergencies and catastrophic disasters in the event first responders are unavailable.

Qualifications: Completion of Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) 20-hr course, National Incident Management System (NIMS) training.

Commitment Expected: Register with the Fire District by completing a Volunteer Application through Volgistics, the District's online volunteer management database; attend an organized CERT meeting/orientation; and take the Disaster Service Worker Loyalty Oath. Additionally, Advanced CERT members will attend quarterly meetings led by Emergency Management Program staff. Advanced CERT members will be subject to the CERT Concept of Operations and all Standard Operating Procedures as designated by the Emergency Management Program. Advanced CERT applicants must successfully pass a Department of Justice (DOJ) background check via Livescan.

Training: Advanced CERT volunteers will be provided opportunities for additional training, which include but are not limited to: Ready! Set! Go!, Leadership Training Skills, and Firefighter Rehab/Support.

Minimum Age: 16

Availability needed: Ongoing
