



Legalizing Pot (Prop 64): Where would the money go?

EXISTING 8% sales tax in SB County (where shops are allowed)

NEW 15% excise tax on retail sales

NEW Excise taxes on cultivation (roughly 10%)



1% to the city or county where shop is located

6.25% state; .75% county roads



First funds go to...


- Reimburse state administrative costs
- \$10 million to research impacts of AUMA
- \$3 million for CHP to establish impairment standards
- \$10 million to mental health, substance abuse grants for communities adversely impacted by past state/fed drug policies
- \$2 million to study medicinal marijuana benefits and impacts



The rest stays with the State for...

20% to Environmental Restoration and Protection Account

20% to State and Local Govt Law Enforcement Account*



60% to Youth Education, Prevention, Early Intervention and Treatment Account



No direct funds for city services; most Marijuana Tax funds stay with the State.



***Cites are not eligible for certain Marijuana Tax Fund grants if they ban retail sales and/or outdoor personal grows in their jurisdictions.**
