• Please provide us with the ages of any children in your group under the age of 18. From this information we will be able to determine what adult supervision is needed for your specific group.

What to Expect on Tour Day

- Once your entire party has arrived at the Center, please have your group or leader check in with the Front Desk.
- Our representative will meet you in the lobby where your tour will begin.
- Tours last approximately one hour, and include an overview of the Animal Center.
- We will be happy to answer any questions you may have throughout the tour.
- Please be advised that children should not bring backpacks or carry any other items during the tour.
- Everyone taking the tour must wear long pants and closed toe shoes.
- Anyone with severe allergies to dogs, cats or rabbits should not attend.
