Why Should I License my Dog?

- A license tag identifies your dog and allows you to be quickly reunited with them in case they every get lost.
- Licensing ensures that dogs are vaccinated against rabies, a fatal disease.
- Licensing your pet helps the Center gauge the number of dogs in the community to prepare for their safety in a disaster.
- It's the law.

Rancho Cucamonga Municipal Code Section 32.0207 Possession of Unvaccinated Dogs.

It shall be unlawful for any person within the City of Rancho Cucamonga, County of San Bernardino, to own, have an interest in, harbor and feed, or have the care, charge, custody, or possession of a dog over the age of four months, unless such dog has a current vaccination with a rabies vaccine approved by the California State Department of Public Health. Vaccination with said vaccine shall be valid for a period not to exceed one year when administered to a dog under one year of age, or three years when administered to a dog over one year of age.

Rancho Cucamonga Municipal Code Section 32.0209 License Responsibility.

Every resident of The City of Rancho Cucamonga in San Bernardino County who owns, has an interest in, harbors and feeds, or has the care, charge, custody, or possession of a dog four months of age or over shall obtain a dog license for such a dog. Each dog shall have a current rabies vaccination as evidenced by a valid rabies certificate issued by the veterinarian who performed the vaccination as a requisite to licensing.

Administrative Citation and Fine - The fine amount for each section violated shall be in the amount of **\$100** for a first violation; **\$200** for a second violation of the same provision of the code within a twelve-month period; and **\$500** for each additional violation of the same provision of the code within a twelve-month period. Fines can increase to \$100, \$500, and \$1,000, respectively. Further, any violations of the City's code(s) are infraction/misdemeanor offenses which are chargeable in court of law and subject to the penalties thereof.
