Pets for Adoption: To adopt a pet, visit www.RCPets.info and select the pet you would like to meet with. You can learn more about each pet by clicking its photo. Call us at (909) 466-7387 to schedule a phone interview. If needed, we will arrange for an in-person meet and greet that adheres to physical distancing. Please note, pets that have a “Full List” hold on our website currently have a full list of people waiting to meet them. Please select another pet to meet.

Lost Pets: Please check our website under Adopt a Pet/ View Pets. Pets that have been brought into the Center will be listed by the date of intake. The most recent pets received will be on the last few pages. If you see your pet, call the Animal Center to make an appointment to reclaim your pet.

Found Pets: Individuals who find stray dogs or injured animals should contact our Field Services Division at (909) 466-7387 option 1 to have a Field Services Officer pick up the animal.

Adult Cats: To provide care for our more critical and vulnerable animals, the Animal Center is temporarily not accepting healthy stray adult cats, including TNR (trap, neuter, return) participants. If you find a healthy stray adult cat, please leave or return them to where they were found.

Kittens: The Animal Center may accept healthy under-aged kittens that reside in Rancho Cucamonga on a case-by-case basis. Contact Field Services at 909-466-7387 option 1 to speak to a member of our cat team.

Surrendering a Pet: The Animal Center is accepting owner surrendered pets by appointment only.

Animal Emergencies: Field Services Officers will continue to respond to public safety and animal welfare calls. Non-priority calls such as animal noise complaints may be deferred until a later date.

Dog Licenses: Dog licenses can be purchased and renewed online at <http://www.cityofrc.us/animal-center/pet-licensing>, mailed to 11780 Arrow Route Rancho Cucamonga, CA 91730, or left in the licensing drop box at the main entrance to the Center. Staff will mail you the receipt and/or tag.

Spay and Neuter Services: The Animal Center offers spay and neuter vouchers for cats and dogs belonging to Rancho Cucamonga residents. Contact the Animal Center to make an appointment for a voucher.

Microchipping Services: The Animal Center offers microchips by appointment only.
