

Q10 Do you live or work in Rancho Cucamonga?



Q11 If you live in Rancho Cucamonga, how long have you lived here?



Q12 If you currently work or previously worked in Rancho Cucamonga, for how long?



Q13 If you work outside of Rancho Cucamonga, where do you work?





Q15 What is your age range?


