The PITC and survey is critical to secure government and private grant funding, as well as other resources for local communities to assist individuals who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

Volunteers may include:

- Social service providers
- Educational institutions
- Community and faith-based organizations
- Local businesses, civic/nonprofit organizations, neighborhood associations and individuals with lived experience

Volunteers must attend a training for safety guidelines and instructions on how to use the Survey 123 mobile application. A smartphone/device will be needed to conduct the count/survey.

Training will be available:

- In-person with hands-on technical assistance
- Virtually with a PowerPoint and instructions for the mobile application
