POSITION DESCRIPTION

Provide enrichment and socialization to available cats and kittens in the public areas.

Tasks:

- Carrying out assigned modification programs designed to help improve the behavior of under socialized cats and kittens.
- Checking ID collars for proper fit and legibility.
- Restocking supplies and completing supply/toy inventory.
- Cleaning and disinfecting cages.
- Following feeding guidelines.
- Reporting any signs of illness to medical staff.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Qualifications: Self-motivation, reliability, and ability to work independently and in teams with limited instruction. Ability to communicate behavioral observations or medical concerns to staff. Comprehension of cat body language for safety in handling. Must be able to bend and stoop often.

Training: Must complete the following training sessions provided by the RCAC staff.

1. Cat Socialization 101
2. Animal Care Attendant 101

1-hour shifts available 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. daily.

To maintain active status as a volunteer, you must commit to at least 8 hours per month, every month.
