


PD-85 was formed in 1985 and consists of single-family homes, condominiums, multi-family units, commercial, industrial, and vacant properties. Each year, property owners within PD-85 pay an annual amount through their annual property tax bill to support the maintenance and capital cost of the two largest parks within the City.

With the funds collected, PD-85 maintains landscaping in public areas such as lawn mowing and fertilizing, tree and shrub trimming, road and sidewalk and parking lot maintenance, irrigation system maintenance, and operation of parks lighting, restroom cleaning, and maintenance of equestrian facilities, playground equipment, picnic facilities, athletic facilities, and water features at the following parks:

- 2. Red Hill Community Park

DROUGHT & WATER CONSERVATION

To comply with statewide water conservation mandates, the City of Rancho Cucamonga has stopped irrigation of "non-functional" turf within some City parkways. This does not include trees and grass used for recreation, such as sports fields, school yards, and parks.
