Healthy (H FERAL)	Healthy feral cat on intake; no placement available	0	3
Healthy (K STRESS)	Healthy animal that developed severe kennel stress with no public or rescue interest	2	0
Treatable (BEHAVIOR)	History of behavior problems may be treatable with experienced owner; no rescue or public interest	0	0
Treatable (K SICK)	Healthy animal on intake that became sick in care and is non responsive to treatment	0	11
Treatable (T Age 0-2W)	Kitten or puppy 1 day to 2 weeks old that failed to thrive in care	0	0
Treatable (T Age 2-8W)	Kitten or puppy 2 weeks to 8 weeks old that failed to thrive in care	0	0
Treatable (T MEDICAL)	Animal with zoonotic disease; unable to isolate and treat at our Animal Center	0	10
