

Senior & Disabled Transportation Services

ACCESS BUS

Access provides curb-to-curb transportation service to Seniors & Disabled individuals. This bus will pick you up from your home and drop you off wherever you need to go. Applications are required and can be printed out online and then mailed, or call 1-909-379-7100 to apply.

OMNITRANS BUS

OmniTrans offers reduced fares for seniors (62 and older), those with a disability, and/or Medicare recipients. Proof of eligibility for discounted passes may be requested at any time. Forms of ID accepted on board include OmniTrans Senior, Disability or ADA Identification cards, Medicare card, or DMV card. Call 1-909-379-7100 to apply.

METROLINK

Seniors and persons with disabilities receive 50% off one way and round trip tickets, 25% off monthly passes and 7 day passes. To be eligible for a discount, please present your photo ID with the date of birth or proof of eligibility to the fare inspector upon request. Passengers with a LA County Access Services ID card can ride for free. Call 1-800-371-5465 for more information.

RIDE TAXI VOUCHER PROGRAM

OmniTrans Ride Program allows seniors and persons with disabilities to purchase Taxi vouchers at a discounted price (up to a \$75 limit) for trips that may be difficult to make on public transportation. Once the fare limit is reached, you are responsible for any additional fares at full price. Call 1-909-379-7341 for more information.

GO GO GRANDPARENT

Connects seniors to ride sharing services like Lyft or Uber. A smartphone is not required, but having a basic cell phone is recommended for convenience. Fees vary, but rates are charged by the minute and up to 4 people may share a ride. Call 1-855-464-6872 for more information.

OMNITRANS UBER PROGRAM

Eligible residents of Rancho Cucamonga can now use Uber for up to half of the cost. Community members who are 62 years or older, or have a disability are eligible. Uber RIDE users can half half of the cost or their ride subsidized, up to \$15 per trip. Travel anywhere in Omnitrans' service area, as long as your trip begins or ends in one of the 15 cities it serves. Call 1-909-379-7341 for more information.
