The City of Rancho Cucamonga invites you to be a part of a "spooky" night by becoming a trunk-or-treat vendor for the annual Spooktacular event. Join us on Saturday, October 21, 2023, at the RC Sports Center for a fun-filled evening of community engagement and putting smiles on all those in attendance! This event invites families to experience trick-or-treating in a safe environment and an opportunity to partake in the pre-paid fun zone and carnival filled with crafts and games!

WHAT IS TRUNK-OR-TREAT?

Trunk-or-treat is a unique spin on your average trick-or-treating that allows the community to have all the trick-or-treating fun without crossing streets or worrying about traffic. Community partners and local businesses/organizations participate by parking their cars in the designated lots — in this case, it would be in the RC Sports Center main parking lot. Trunk vendors open their trunks, or back of their vehicles, and decorate them! If no trunk is available, you are more than welcome to decorate your area with the available resources you have. Trunk vendors are required to be self-sufficient in providing candy and/or giveaways for 5,000 people.

HOW MUCH IS IT TO PARTICIPATE AND HOW DO I SIGN UP?

To participate as a trunk vendor, you will need to complete the application linked <u>HERE</u> and submit a payment of \$50. You do have the option of purchasing additional spaces, as needed. Please note, you are responsible for providing a pre-packaged treat to hand out and staffing your own trunk. Don't forget to decorate your space, attendees love it, and you could win BEST DECORATED! We encourage you to share brochures, giveaways, etc. to promote your organization. Just remember, handing out a treat and engaging with our community is a priority for this event.

WHO CAN HAVE A TRUNK AND WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

All are welcome to trunk-or-treat as it is a free component of the event! To ensure your experience is beneficial and the community attending is engaged, we are relying on our community partners and local businesses to be self-sufficient when being a trunk vendor. All trunk vendors will be required to decorate their trunks, attend the event for its entirety, and supply wrapped candy to approximately 5,000 people in attendance.
