Key Priorities

REIMAGINING Archibald Avenue

The Cucamonga Town Center Focus Area aims to transform Archibald Avenue into a vibrant, people-first “Main Street” for Southwest Rancho Cucamonga.

By prioritizing walkability, enhancing bike-friendly routes, and improving connectivity between neighborhoods, shopping centers, and business parks, the plan strengthens accessibility for all.

Through a series of impactful improvements, the area will evolve into a true community destination anchored by the future Cucamonga Town Square—bringing people together and supporting a thriving, welcoming town center.

Archibald Main Street

Improve Archibald Avenue as a “main street” connecting commercial and civic amenities with pedestrian-friendly streets.

Cucamonga Town Square

Create a lively activity center as a focal point on 9th Street through outdoor dining and public gathering spaces.

Improved Connectivity

Create a complete street network that improves connectivity and access to and from Town Center to neighboring destinations.

8th Street Trail

Create a new multipurpose trail along 8th Street with a direct connection to Cucamonga Station.
